Overview

On this tour you will see the Amalfi Coast from all three perspectives – land, sea and "air".

We'll drive along much of the spectacular coast road, we'll sail along the coast and we'll take the fabulous "Path of the gods" hilltop hike and see the coast from aboveas if from the air!!

Heard of Vietri pottery? We'll see it at the source at nearby Vietri-sul-Mare.

Of course we'll visit the highlights: busy Sorrento,


elegant Positano and, capital of the coast, in Amalfi. We'll drive up to hilltop Ravello, famous for its gardens, its villas and the magnificent view.

And then there's **Pompeii**. August 24th will never be the same again after you hear from your fascinating professional guide what happened in 79AD, the year Vesuvius erupted.

One hour's drive south are three of the best-preserved Greek temples in the world at Paestum, dating from the time of the first Bet HaMikdash!!

You'll love the boat-ride to romantic Capri, with the sun in your face and sea breeze in your hair. It is an magical day tour, recalling the jet-set and the classic movies of the 60's and 70's filmed there. Take the chair-lift, browse the shops and even a short nature walk.

If you wish to fly to Rome, and perhaps stay over a day or two, you can come by train to Naples station, just over a one hour ride

Not far from the airport are Naples and Pompeii. There will be a guided tour of this incredible, unique archeological site, preserved by the ash from the eruption of Vesuvius in 79 CE.

Did you know that there is evidence that Roman Jews believed that the eruption of Vesuvius and the huge destruction caused thereby resulted from the Romans' destruction of the 2nd Bet Mikdash just 9 years previously in Jerusalem???




We then head to our Villa Hotel in Vietri for dinner and a good night's sleep.

The highlights of the tour are below. The exact order will be dependent on then current ferry schedules. The objective is to incorporate all the major sights in a way that leaves the guests feeling at the end that they had a vacation, not run a marathon.

We will visit:-

The Amalfi Coast by boat – there are stops in Amalfi, Positano, Capri and Sorrento

Amalfi – we'll stroll around this busy little town, look at the church and its art (for those who so wish) or browse in the stores and "live the life". There is also a lovely museum of papermaking at the end of the village which was probably owned by Jews... 1000+ years ago.



Ravello – a bus will take us to the "high-point" of the coast with its breath-taking Villa Cimbrone gardens and views.





Vietri-sul-Mare – very close to where we are staying is the town made famous worldwide by its colorful pottery.

We'll take an hour or so for you can look at the traditional and modern ceramics still being produced here.

Paestum – we'll learn so much on a guided tour of the world's best preserved Greek Temples (yes, *Greek* – from the time when the Greeks colonized Southern Italy). They are among the best preserved in the world and date from about 550 BCE, just 35 years after OUR 1st temple was destroyed in Jerusalem תובב"א.



We need exercise!! The "pathway of the gods" is a 3-hour medium difficulty hike on top of the cliffs above the Amalfi coastline with some of the ultimate views of the coast. If you can hike, this is often THE highlight of the whole tour.... if not, we'll offer some other activity or tour to give you a great time too!!



Positano is one of the most famous must-sees on the coast with its spectacular approach from the sea. There's no transport inside Positano (as in much of the region) so it's a walk down through the narrow ancient streets, filled with art and craft shops, coffee shops and boutiques (yes, touristy stuff) until we reach the port at the bottom, to catch a boat.





Capri is unique in many ways: we will head straight up to Anacapri at the top to take a cable car to the summit. Coming down to the town of Capri, we'll pass by the fancy shops (or you can visit them – we can't stop you; there'll be a meeting point later before we leave) and take a gentle stroll to appreciate the natural beauty spots. Everyone loves Capri – each for his/her own reason.

flights: we will meet you in Naples (NAP) Airport or at the airport for the pre-tour. Departure – we will find the best solution for each guest to reach the airport at the appropriate time, matching guests where possible to reduce transfer costs.

spending money for shopping: we will try to take you to places where your money will buy you more, but we will look after you so well that you will not NEED to spend anything at all!!

upgrades: deluxe rooms (DLX) and single occupancy are available at an additional price (see booking form).
